7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (third of four) of a**
8 **professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services for**
9 **a one-year term, from 1/1/26 through 12/31/26, in an amount not to exceed \$7,133,070.65, for**
10 **the Executive's Department of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2023-021, which confirmed
13 the award by the Board of Control of professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc., for
14 day reporting, driver intervention, home incarceration, multiple offender, and residential
15 community correction programming, for a one year term, from 1/1/23 through 12/31/23, with four
16 options to renew for an additional one-year term, in an amount not to exceed \$8,980,912.97, for
17 the Executive's Department of Public Safety; and

19 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2024-013, which
20 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (first of four) of a professional service
21 contract with Oriana House, Inc., for day reporting, driver intervention, home incarceration,
22 multiple offender, and residential community correction programming, for a one year term, from
23 1/1/24 through 12/31/24, in an amount not to exceed \$9,250,340.35, for the Executive's
24 Department of Public Safety; and

26 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2025-028, which
27 confirmed the award by the Board of Control of a renewal (second of four) of a professional service
28 contract with Oriana House, Inc., for day reporting, driver intervention, home incarceration,
29 multiple offender, and residential community correction programming, for a one year term, from
30 1/1/25 through 12/31/25, in an amount not to exceed \$9,490,655.40, for the Executive's
31 Department of Public Safety; and

33 WHEREAS, the Executive and Oriana House Inc. agreed to remove the Community
34 Alternative Sentencing Center ("CASC") from the residential programming of the section of this
35 renewal for community corrections services, and establish a separate contract for the CASC; and

37 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held November 19, 2025, awarded a
38 renewal (third of four) of a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community
39 corrections services for a one-year term, from 1/1/26 through 12/31/26, in an amount not to exceed
40 \$7,133,070.65, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

42 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the
43 aforementioned renewal of a professional service contract with Oriana House, Inc. is necessary
44 and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

6 The award by the Board of Control of a renewal (third of four) of a professional service
7 contract with Oriana House, Inc. for community corrections services for a one-year term, from
8 1/1/26 through 12/31/26, in an amount not to exceed \$7,133,070.65, is hereby confirmed and the
9 Executive is hereby authorized to execute said renewal of a professional service contract and any
10 necessary related documents.

14 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
15 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose of immediately
16 providing continued community corrections services effective 1/1/26.

20 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect
21 immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and
22 be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

26 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
27 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
28 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were

30 of the Ohio Revised Code.
