7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to advertise for bids for construction of Project Q-**
8 **165-1 Akron-Cleveland Road Sanitary Sewer Extension, located in the City of Cuyahoga**
9 **Falls and Boston Township, in Council Districts 1, 2 and 3, for an amount not to exceed**
10 **\$3,794,222.72, that will be partially funded by American Rescue Plan Act funds and a loan**
11 **from the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund, for the Executive's Department of Sanitary**
12 **Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the County desires to extend sanitary sewers on Akron-Cleveland Road, in
15 the City of Cuyahoga Falls and Boston Township ("Q-165-1 Project"), in Council Districts 1, 2
16 and 3; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2023-078 and Resolution
19 No. 2012-157 to authorize the Executive to execute a professional services contract with GBC
20 Design, Inc., to prepare engineering design plans and specifications for the Q-165-1 Project; and

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22 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2024-024 to authorize the
23 Executive to execute a Cooperative Funding Intergovernmental Agreement with Boston
24 Township for Boston Township to provide a local share contribution to partially fund
25 construction for the Q-165-1 Project; and to authorize the Executive to apply for and execute a
26 loan from the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund with the Ohio Environmental Protection
27 Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority and use available American Rescue Plan Act
28 funds to finance the design and construction of the Q-165-1 Project; and

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30 WHEREAS, this Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2025-130 to authorize the
31 Executive to execute agreements for the acquisition of sanitary sewer easements over a portion
32 of Akron-Cleveland Road and Seasons Road for construction of the Q-165-1 Project; and

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34 WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to advertise for bids for construction of the Q-165-1
35 Project for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$3,794,222.72; and

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37 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinance of the County of Summit requires
38 this Council's authorization for the Executive to advertise for bids for construction contracts in
39 excess of \$75,000.00; and

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41 WHEREAS, a copy of the plans and specifications for the Q-165-1 Project are on file
42 with the Clerk of Council; and

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44 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
45 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to advertise
46 for bids for the construction of the Q-165-1 Project for an estimated total cost not to exceed
47 \$3,794,222.72;

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49 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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4 SECTION 1

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6 The Executive is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of Project Q-
7 165-1 Akron-Cleveland Road Sanitary Sewer Extension ("Q-165-1 Project"), located in the City
8 of Cuyahoga Falls and Boston Township, in Council Districts 1, 2 and 3, for an amount not to
9 exceed \$3,794,222.72, that will be partially funded by American Rescue Plan Act funds and a loan
10 from the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund.

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12 SECTION 2

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14 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare
15 of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately advertise for
16 bids for construction of the Q-165-1 Project so that the project may proceed in a timely manner.

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18 SECTION 3

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20 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
21 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
22 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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24 SECTION 4

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26 It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating
27 to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
28 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
29 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
30 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
