17		WHEREAS, in 1996, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency issued a consent order		
18	to the City of Hudson, in Council District 3, to close five engineered sanitary sewer overflows ("SSOs"); and			
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20		r Hudson has ne	erformed a series of flow	
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studies and rehabilitative work on the sanitary sewer system which resulted in the closure of three of the five SSOs; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2015-458 which authorized the Executive to execute a Sanitary Sewer Transfer Agreement to acquire the Hudson sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the Council subsequently adopted Resolution No. 2015-498 which further amended the Board of Commissioners Resolution No. 743-70 to add Hudson to the County Metropolitan Sewer District; and

WHEREAS, when the County acquired the Hudson sanitary sewer system, it accepted responsibility for elimination of the remaining SSOs; and

WHEREAS, the Executive wishes to proceed with Project Q-186 Elimination of Hudson Sanitary Sewer Overflow Area L ("Q-186 Project"), located in the City of Hudson, in Council District 3, to eliminate the SSO in Area "L", one of the remaining SSOs; and

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2017-358 to authorize the Executive to execute a professional service contract with Environmental Design Group, LLC for professional engineering services for the Q-186 Project; and

WHEREAS, the County of Summit and the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (the "District") wish to enter into a Member Community Infrastructure Grant Program Agreement ("Grant Agreement") for the Q-186 Project and to authorize the Executive to execute any other documents necessary to accept a grant from the District in an amount not to exceed \$600,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the Q-186 Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 177.21 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, only the approval of this Council is required for intergovernmental agreements; and

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WHEREAS, the District requires the legislative authority of the County to adopt legislation for the execution of the Grant Agreement and the acceptance of its grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the County intends to apply for and execute a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund ("WPCLF") loan agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority ("OWDA") for a loan, with a term of 20 years, in an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000.00, to finance the engineering design and construction cost for the Q-186 Project; and

WHEREAS, WPCLF requires the legislative authority of the County to adopt legislation for the application of loans, the execution of agreements and the designation of repayment sources; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information, that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute the Grant Agreement with the District and any other documents necessary to accept grant funds and to authorize the Executive to apply for and execute the WPCLF loan agreement and designate repayment from the Sanitary Sewer Enterprise Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute a Member Community Infrastructure Grant Program Agreement ("Grant Agreement") with the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (the "District") for Project Q-186 Elimination of Hudson Sanitary Sewer Overflow Area L, located in the City of Hudson, in Council District 3 ("Q-186 Project"), which is attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of the Grant Agreement and not substantially adverse to the County.

SECTION 2

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept a grant from the District in an amount not to exceed \$600,000.00, with no local cash match requirement, for the Q-186 Project and any other necessary documents related to the Grant Agreement.

SECTION 3

The Executive is hereby authorized to apply for and execute a Water Pollution Control Loan Fund Loan Agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority, for a loan, with a term of 20 years, in an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000.00, to finance the engineering design and construction cost for the Q-186 Project, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit B, with such modifications and revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of the loan agreement and not substantially adverse to the County and execute any other necessary documents. This Council further designates the Sanitary Sewer Enterprise Fund as the dedicated source of repayment for the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund loan.
