7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a collective bargaining agreement**
8 **between The Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. (Deputy Unit), and the**
9 **County of Summit, for the period of 1/1/26 through 12/31/28, for the Executive and the**
10 **Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

11
12 WHEREAS, a collective bargaining agreement has been reached between The Fraternal
13 Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. (Deputy Unit), and the Executive, for the period of
14 1/1/26 through 12/31/28, with an increase in pay of four percent (4.0%) in the first year of the
15 agreement (1/1/26), three and one-half percent (3.5%) in the second year of the agreement
16 (1/1/27), and three percent (3.0%) in the third year of the agreement (1/1/28); and

18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
19 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute the
20 aforementioned collective bargaining agreement;

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
23 of Ohio, that:

25 SECTION 1

27 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute a collective bargaining agreement between
28 The Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. (Deputy Unit), and the County of
29 Summit, for the period of 1/1/26 through 12/31/28, with an increase in pay of four percent
30 (4.0%) in the first year of the agreement (1/1/26), three and one-half percent (3.5%) in the
31 second year of the agreement (1/1/27), and three percent (3.0%) in the third year of the
32 agreement (1/1/28).

36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
37 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of providing a
38 timely collective bargaining agreement between The Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor
39 Council, Inc. (Deputy Unit), and the Executive.

43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
