7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **ICOR Technology, Inc for three tactical robots for various Special Operations Teams in**
9 **Ohio Homeland Security Region 5, for an amount not to exceed \$179,885.88, for the**
10 **Executive’s Department of Public Safety, Emergency Management Agency, and declaring**
11 **an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2025-325, which authorized
14 the Executive to advertise for bids for three tactical robots for the Akron Police Department SWAT
15 Team, Cuyahoga Falls Police Department SWAT Team, and Mahoning Valley Crisis Response
16 Team, for an amount not to exceed \$297,600.00; and

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18 WHEREAS, said equipment will be fully grant-funded through the State Homeland
19 Security Program (“SHSP”) grant; and

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21 WHEREAS, the Executive has selected ICOR Technology, Inc which was the lowest of
22 three bids and met the required minimum equipment specification to provide three tactical robots
23 for various special operations teams, in the Ohio Homeland Security Region 5, in an amount not
24 to exceed \$179,885.88; and

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26 WHEREAS, a tactical robot is a remote-controlled unmanned vehicle that can be used by
27 Teams for information gathering in high-risk environments; and

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29 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on January 7, 2026, awarded said
30 purchase contract with ICOR Technology, Inc., as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder,
31 subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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33 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
34 that the aforementioned purchase contract with ICOR Technology, Inc. is necessary and in the best
35 interest of the County of Summit;

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37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
38 of Ohio, that;

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42 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with ICOR Technology, Inc for
43 three tactical robots for various special operations teams in Ohio Homeland Security Region 5, in
44 an amount not to exceed \$179,885.88, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized
45 to execute said purchase contract and any other necessary related documents.

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49 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
50 of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the Executive
51 to immediately executed a necessary contract in order to procure the necessary equipment within
52 the grant performance period.
