7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**
8 **WEX Bank, at Sourcewell pricing, for fleet fuel card services and miscellaneous small**
9 **vehicle expenses, in an amount not to exceed \$350,000.00, for the Sheriff, and declaring an**
10 **emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the Sheriff's fleet of vehicles requires a fuel source, and the Sheriff has
13 requested WEX Bank, at Sourcewell Pricing, as a public purchasing cooperative, pursuant to
14 Section 177.07(a)(11) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, as the vendor to
15 provide said fuel with a one percent discount off the fuel pump price; and

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17 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on January 21, 2026, awarded a
18 purchase contract with WEX Bank, at Sourcewell pricing, for fleet fuel card services and
19 miscellaneous small vehicle expenses, in an amount not to exceed \$350,000.00, subject to
20 confirmation by this Council; and

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22 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
23 that the aforementioned purchase contract with WEX Bank is necessary and in the best interest
24 of the County of Summit;

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26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
27 of Ohio, that:

29 SECTION 1

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31 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with WEX Bank, at Sourcewell
32 pricing, for fleet fuel card services and miscellaneous small vehicle expenses, in an amount not
33 to exceed \$350,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute
34 said purchase contract and any other necessary related documents.

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36 SECTION 2

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38 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
39 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
40 provide for necessary fleet fuel card services and vehicle expenses so that the Sheriff's Office
41 may continue effective policing within the County.

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43 SECTION 3

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45 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
46 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
47 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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6 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
7 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
8 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
9 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
10 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
