7 **An Amended Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into an agreement with the**
8 **Ohio Department of Transportation and to appropriate funds for the construction costs for**
9 **the relocation of the sanitary sewer line due to the bridge deck replacement on State Route**
10 **91, located in the City of Munroe Falls, in Council District 3, for the Executive's**
11 **Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.**

12

13 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2025-338, which authorized
14 the County to cooperate with the Ohio Department of Transportation (“ODOT”) whereby ODOT
15 is undertaking the bridge deck replacement project on North Main Street (State Route 91), in
16 Munroe Falls, Bridge No. SFN 7707142 over the Cuyahoga River, identified as SUM 91/07.89,
17 PID 113201 (“ODOT Deck Replacement Project”) that includes the removal, replacement and
18 relocation of the County’s sanitary sewer line under ODOT’s North Main Street bridge (“Sewer
19 Line Project”); and has enacted the aforementioned Preliminary Participatory Legislation
20 consenting to such project and agreeing to participate in costs; and

22 WHEREAS, the County shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation and shall
23 assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost of the Sewer Line Project work,
24 less the amount of Federal-Aid funds set aside by the Director of Transportation for the financing
25 of this improvement from funds allocated by the Federal Highway Administration, U.S.
26 Department of Transportation; and

28 WHEREAS, the share of the cost to the County is now estimated in the amount of
29 ~~\$207,310.00~~ \$412,470.00, but said estimated amount is to be adjusted in order that the County's
30 ultimate share of said improvement shall correspond with the actual costs when said actual costs
31 are determined; and

33 WHEREAS, the Director of Transportation has approved said Preliminary Participatory
34 Legislation proposing cooperation and has caused to be made plans and specifications and an
35 estimate of cost and expense for the ODOT Bridge Deck Replacement Project on the North Main
36 Street bridge to include the Sewer Line Project and has transmitted copies of the same to the
37 County; and

39 WHEREAS, the County desires the Director of Transportation to proceed with the
40 aforesaid Sewer Line Project;

41

42 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
43 of Ohio, that;

45 SECTION 1

46

47 A. The County will enter into a Local Public Authority (“LPA”) contract with the State
48 through the Director of Transportation, and that the Executive is hereby authorized to execute
49 said LPA contract, providing for the payment of the sum of money set forth herein for the Sewer
50 Line Project. Furthermore, the Executive is hereby authorized to execute any contracts and/or
51 other necessary related documents with the Director of Transportation as may be necessary to
52 complete the aforementioned Sewer Line Project under ODOT’s Deck Replacement Project.

4 B. The estimated sum of ~~\$207,310.00~~ \$412,470.00 is hereby appropriated for the Sewer
5 Line Project improvement described above and the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and
6 directed to issue an order and certification for said sum upon the requisition of the Director of
7 Transportation to pay the cost and expense of said improvement. The County hereby agrees to
8 assume in the first instance, the share of the cost and expense over and above the amount to be
9 paid from Federal funds.

10

11 C. The County hereby requests the Director of Transportation to proceed with the
12 aforesaid Sewer Line Project.

13

14 D. The Clerk of Council shall transmit to the Director of Transportation a fully executed
15 and certified copy of this Resolution.

17 SECTION 2

18

19 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
20 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately
21 facilitates sewer line improvements in the City of Munroe Falls, in Council District 3.

23 SECTION 3

24

25 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
26 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
27 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

29 SECTION 4

31 It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating
32 to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
33 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
34 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
35 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
