7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive, subject to the approval of the Board of Control and**  
8 **Information Technology Board, to execute a purchase contract with Sadler-Necamp**  
9 **Financial Services, Inc. dba Proware, as a Best Practical Source, for a data conversion and**  
10 **establishing an API for on-going data sharing, in an amount not to exceed \$104,500.00, for**  
11 **the Executive’s Department of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Executive’s Department of Public Safety wishes to enter into a purchase  
14 contract with Sadler-Necamp Financial Services, Inc. dba Proware (“Proware”) for an initial data  
15 conversion and building an API for on-going data sharing between the Ohio Community  
16 Supervision Software (“OCSS”) and Proware, the Court of Common Pleas-General Division’s  
17 case management system, in an amount not to exceed \$104,500.00; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council previous adopted Resolution No. 2024-338, which confirmed the  
20 award by the Board of Control and the Information Technology Board, of a professional service  
21 contract with StepMobile, LLC for the implementation of the Ohio Community Supervision  
22 System, in an amount not to exceed \$97,485.00; and

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24 WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas-General Division utilizes Proware for their case-  
25 management system, therefore an integration between OCSS and Proware is critical for the  
26 operation of the Court; and

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28 WHEREAS, the purchase contract is exempt from competitive bidding because Proware is  
29 the Best Practical Source pursuant to Section 177.07(a)(5) of the Codified Ordinances of the  
30 County of Summit as they are the current provider of the case-management system; and, as part of  
31 the purchase of the 9-1-1 system; and

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33 WHEREAS, this project will be funded by the Targeted Community Alternatives to Prison  
34 Program grant funds and as the Department of Public Safety is already in the grant extension time  
35 period for this time sensitive project First Reading Passage is requested; and

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37 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting to be held on April 1, 2026, will consider  
38 a purchase contract, subject to the approval of the Information Technology Board, with Proware,  
39 as a Best Practical Source, for a data conversion and establishing an API for on-going data sharing,  
40 in an amount not to exceed \$104,500.00; and

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42 WHEREAS, the Office of Information Technology Board, at its meeting to be held on  
43 April 9, 2026, will consider the aforementioned purchase contract with Proware; and

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45 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
46 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
47 execute, subject to the approval of the Board of Control and Information Technology Board, the  
48 aforementioned purchase contract with Proware;

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6 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute, subject to the approval of the Board of  
7 Control and Information Technology Board, the purchase of contract and any other necessary  
8 related documents with Sadler-Necamp Financial Services, Inc. dba Proware, as a Best Practical  
9 Source, for a data conversion and establishing an API for on-going data sharing, in an amount not  
10 to exceed \$104,500.00.

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12 SECTION 2

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14 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety, and  
15 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to be able to provide  
16 continuity of public safety services to the residents of Summit County.
