7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**
8 **Melway Paving Company, Inc., for the 2026 Summit County 422 Resurfacing Program, in**
9 **an amount not to exceed \$1,287,188.95, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2025-333, which authorized
12 the Executive to advertise, as needed, for bridge engineering and construction projects, and
13 pavement maintenance projects, for the Engineer's 2026 Capital Improvements Program, and
14 federal and state funded projects, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$7,925,000.00; and

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16 WHEREAS, said projects were approved as part of the Capital Improvements Program
17 for 2026-2031 by Resolution No. 2026-009; and

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19 WHEREAS, the work to be performed will consist of resurfacing various County, Bath
20 Township, Copley Township, Coventry Township, Richfield Township, Sagamore Hills
21 Township, and Springfield Township roads, by applying 422 Chip Seal; and

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23 WHEREAS, the contract total will be broken down by political subdivision as follows
24 with each subdivision responsible for directly paying the contractor:

27 Bath Township: \$136,762.50
28 Copley Township: \$87,638.50 (Includes Alternate No. 1 & Alternate No. 2)
29 Coventry Township: \$659,087.00 (Includes Alternate No. 3)
30 Richfield Township: \$39,389.50
31 Springfield Township: \$104,052.10
32 Sagamore Hills Township: \$73,325.75; and

34 WHEREAS, the Engineer sent out four bid packets and following the receipt and review
35 of two bids, the Executive proposes entering into a construction contract with Melway Paving
36 Company, Inc., as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, for the 2026 Summit County
37 422 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to exceed \$1,287,188.95; and

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39 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on March 18, 2026, awarded a
40 construction contract with Melway Paving Company, Inc., as the lowest responsive and
41 responsible bidder, for the 2026 Summit County 422 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to
42 exceed \$1,287,188.95, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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44 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
45 that the aforementioned construction contract with Melway Paving Company, Inc. is necessary
46 and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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6 The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Melway Paving
7 Company, Inc., for the 2026 Summit County 422 Resurfacing Program, in an amount not to
8 exceed \$1,287,188.95 is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said
9 construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

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11 SECTION 2

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13 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
14 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
15 providing a necessary construction contract for the 2026 Summit County 422 Resurfacing
16 Program.

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18 SECTION 3

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20 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
21 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
22 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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26 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
27 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
28 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
