7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into a Cooperative Funding**  
8 **Intergovernmental Agreement with the Village of Lakemore, for the rehabilitation of**  
9 **sanitary sewer lines as part of the Lakemore Infrastructure Improvements Project, located**  
10 **in the Village of Lakemore, in Council District 8, in an amount not to exceed \$321,705.00,**  
11 **for the Executive's Department of Sanitary Sewer Services, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the County plans to rehabilitate approximately 3,134 linear feet of 8"  
14 sanitary sewer cured-in-place pipe lining, approximately 3,093 linear feet of 12" sanitary sewer  
15 cured-in-place pipe lining and install a new manhole, located in the Village of Lakemore, in  
16 Council District 8 ("County Sewer Project"); and

18 WHEREAS, the Village of Lakemore is undertaking certain infrastructure improvements  
19 to rehabilitate sanitary sewer lines with cured-in-place pipe lining, replacing sanitary sewer lines,  
20 installing new water lines and completing a full-depth replacement of approximately 900 feet of  
21 roadway ("Lakemore Project"); and

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23 WHEREAS, recognizing there is greater efficiency in both cost and logistics if the  
24 respective projects are combined, the Village of Lakemore and the County desire to enter into a  
25 Cooperative Funding Intergovernmental Agreement whereby the Village of Lakemore shall  
26 incorporate the County Sewer Project as part of the Lakemore Project and the County shall pay  
27 the Village of Lakemore for the completion of the County Sewer Project in an amount not to  
28 exceed \$321,705.00; and

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30 WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Lakemore adopted a resolution authorizing  
31 the Village to enter into the Cooperative Funding Intergovernmental Agreement with the County;

34 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 177.21(b) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of  
35 Summit, this Council's approval is required to authorize the Executive to execute the  
36 Cooperative Funding Intergovernmental Agreement with the Village of Lakemore; and

38 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
39 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the Executive to execute the  
40 Cooperative Funding Intergovernmental Agreement with the Village of Lakemore;

42 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
43 of Ohio, that:

45 SECTION 1

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47 The Executive is authorized to execute a Cooperative Funding Intergovernmental  
48 Agreement with the Village of Lakemore, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and  
49 incorporated fully herein, and any other necessary related documents, whereby the Village of  
50 Lakemore shall incorporate the County Sewer Project as part of the Lakemore Project, and the  
51 County shall pay the Village of Lakemore for construction of the County Sewer Project, located  
52 in the Village of Lakemore, in Council District 8, in an amount not to exceed \$321,705.00.

6 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare  
7 of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately execute a  
8 necessary agreement so that the project may proceed in a timely manner.

12 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
13 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
14 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

19 to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
20 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
