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7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to enter into a cooperative agreement with the city**
8 **of Cuyahoga Falls concerning the Resurfacing of Sand Run Road, located in Bath**
9 **Township, in Council District 5, at an estimated cost to the County of \$123,240.00, for the**
10 **Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the County and the City of Cuyahoga Falls are in agreement that the
13 Resurfacing of Sand Run Road between Sourek Trail and Yellow Creek Road (the “Project”) is
14 necessary; and

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16 WHEREAS, the Project is a joint venture between the County and the City of Cuyahoga
17 Falls as Sand Run Road runs through both jurisdictions; and,

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19 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls will be administering the Project, located in Bath
20 Township, in Council District 5, at an estimated cost to the County of \$123,240.00; and

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22 WHEREAS, it is necessary for the parties to execute a cooperative agreement to set forth
23 the rights and duties of the parties concerning the Project, attached hereto as Exhibit A and
24 incorporated herein as if fully restated; and

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26 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is
27 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to enter
28 into an agreement with the City of Cuyahoga Falls for the aforementioned Project;

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30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
31 of Ohio, that;

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33 SECTION 1

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35 The Executive is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the
36 City of Cuyahoga Falls to outline responsibilities for the Resurfacing of Sand Run Road Project,
37 located in Bath Township, in Council District 5, at an estimated cost to the County of
38 \$123,240.00. The final agreement will be substantially in the form as the agreement attached
39 hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully restated, with such modifications and
40 revisions as shall be in furtherance of the provisions of said intergovernmental agreement and not
41 substantially adverse to the County, all of which shall be conclusively evidenced by the
42 execution thereof by the execution thereof by the Executive.

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46 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
47 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
48 allow the Executive to execute an agreement for a needed resurfacing project in Summit County.
