7 **A Resolution approving salary adjustments for various classified non-bargaining**
8 **employees, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

10 WHEREAS, the Prosecutor wishes to grant salary adjustments for various classified non-
11 bargaining employees in the Child Support Enforcement Agency division of his office based
12 upon increased responsibilities and pay equity; and

13

14 WHEREAS, a copy of all the proposed salary adjustments including names, current
15 positions and class numbers, and current and new salaries is attached hereto as Exhibit A and
16 incorporated fully herein; and

18 WHEREAS, because salary adjustments for the aforementioned employees represent pay
19 increases under Section 169.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, this
20 Council’s approval is required; and

22 WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Human Resources will review the
23 personnel actions for the aforementioned salary adjustments as required by Section 169.07(b) of
24 the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit; and

26 WHEREAS, the salary adjustments will be submitted to the Director of the Department
27 of Finance and Budget for the certification of availability of appropriated funds, as required by
28 Section 169.07(b) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit; and

30 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
31 that the aforementioned salary adjustments are necessary and in the best interest of the County of
32 Summit;

34 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
35 State of Ohio, that:

39 This Council hereby determines that the Prosecutor has demonstrated that it is necessary
40 for the effective and continued operation of his office to authorize the Prosecutor’s Office to
41 make the following salary adjustments retroactive to April 20, 2026 as defined on Exhibit A,
42 which is attached hereto and incorporated fully herein.

46 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
47 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately
48 authorize the Prosecutor to timely make the aforementioned salary adjustments for the classified
49 non-bargaining employees listed on Exhibit A.
