7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**  
8 **Cistones Excavating Services, LLC for the 2026 Summit County Culvert Replacement**  
9 **Program, in an amount not to exceed \$224,728.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an**  
10 **emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2025-333, which authorized  
13 the Executive to advertise for bids as needed for road and bridge construction projects in the  
14 Engineer’s 2026 Capital Improvement Program at an estimated cost not to exceed  
15 \$7,925,000.00; and

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17 WHEREAS, the 2026 Summit County Culvert Replacement Program (the “Program”)  
18 was submitted to this Council as part of the Capital Improvements Program for 2026-2031  
19 pursuant to Resolution No. 2026-009; and

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21 WHEREAS, the Program includes removal, replacement, and rehabilitation of CMP  
22 culverts and pipe culverts also including the placement of rock channel protection and  
23 construction of a concrete rip rap; and

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25 WHEREAS, the first proposed work site is Akron Peninsula Road culvert No. 10-30984  
26 removal and replacement of an existing 24” CMP culvert with a new 30” HDPE culvert and  
27 headwalls. This site also includes pavement replacement, channel protection and regrading  
28 embankment at ends of the culvert. The second proposed work site is Medina Line Road culvert  
29 No. 2-826686 for partial removal of stone headwall, full removal of culvert and replacement with  
30 30” HDPE conduit, new headwall and embankment reconstruction. This site also includes  
31 pavement and guardrail replacement and regarding of stream to enter the new culvert; and

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33 WHEREAS, the Engineer distributed eight bid packages and following the receipt and  
34 review of two bids, the Executive wishes to enter into a construction contract with Cistones  
35 Excavating Services, LLC, as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, for the Program, in  
36 an amount not to exceed \$224,728.00; and

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38 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held April 22, 2026, awarded a  
39 construction contract with Cistones Excavating Services, LLC, as the lowest responsive and  
40 responsible bidder, for the 2026 Summit County Culvert Replacement Program, in an amount  
41 not to exceed \$224,728.00, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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43 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
44 that the aforementioned construction contract with Cistones Excavating Services, LLC is  
45 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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47 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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6 The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Cistones Excavating  
7 Services, LLC for the 2026 Summit County Culvert Replacement Program (the "Program"), in  
8 an amount not to exceed \$224,728.00, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby  
9 authorized to execute said construction contract and any necessary related documents.

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11 SECTION 2

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13 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
14 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
15 provide for a necessary construction contract for the Program in order for it to proceed as  
16 expeditiously as possible.

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18 SECTION 3

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20 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
21 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
22 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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24 SECTION 4

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26 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
27 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
28 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
29 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
30 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
