7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**  
8 **Pavement Technology, Inc. for the 2026 Summit County Regional Asphalt Rejuvenating**  
9 **Program, in an amount not to exceed \$183,288.84, for the Engineer, and declaring an**  
10 **emergency.**

11  
12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2025-333, which authorized  
13 the Executive to advertise for bids as needed for road and bridge construction projects in the  
14 Engineer’s 2026 Capital Improvement Program at an estimated cost not to exceed  
15 \$7,925,000.00; and

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17 WHEREAS, the Project was submitted to this Council as part of the Capital  
18 Improvements Program for 2026-2031 pursuant to Resolution No. 2026-009; and

19  
20 WHEREAS, the proposed work consists of furnishing all labor, equipment, and material,  
21 and performing all operations necessary for the rejuvenation and in-depth sealing of asphaltic-  
22 concrete surface courses by spray application of a cationic rejuvenating agent composed of  
23 petroleum oils and resins emulsified with water in accordance with the specifications and terms  
24 of the contract; and

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26 WHEREAS, the Engineer sent out nine bid packages and following the receipt and  
27 review of one bid, the Executive proposes entering into a construction contract with Pavement  
28 Technology, Inc., as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, for the 2026 Summit County  
29 Regional Asphalt Rejuvenating Program, in an amount not to exceed \$183,288.84; and

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31 WHEREAS, the contract total will be broken down by political subdivision as follows  
32 with each subdivision responsible for directly paying Pavement Technology, Inc.:

34 County share: \$113,607.58  
35 Northfield Center Township: \$44,937.43  
36 Twinsburg Township: \$24,743.83; and

38 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held April 15, 2026, awarded a  
39 construction contract with Pavement Technology, Inc., as the lowest responsive and responsible  
40 bidder, for the 2026 Summit County Regional Asphalt Rejuvenating Program, in an amount not  
41 to exceed \$183,288.84, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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43 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
44 that aforementioned construction contract with Pavement Technology, Inc. is necessary and in  
45 the best interest of the County of Summit;

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6 The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with Pavement Technology,  
7 Inc. for the 2026 Summit County Regional Asphalt Rejuvenating Program, in an amount not to  
8 exceed \$183,288.84, is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute said  
9 construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

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11 SECTION 2

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13 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
14 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately  
15 provide a necessary construction contract for the 2026 Summit County Regional Asphalt  
16 Rejuvenating Program.

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20 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
21 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
22 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
