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7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with**
8 **American Roadway Logistics, Inc. for the 2026 Summit County Regional Pavement**
9 **Marking Program, in an amount not to exceed \$416,704.70, for the Engineer, and declaring**
10 **an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2025-333, which authorized
13 the Executive to advertise for bids as needed for road and bridge construction projects in the
14 Engineer's 2026 Capital Improvement Program at an estimated cost not to exceed
15 \$7,925,000.00; and

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17 WHEREAS, the 2026 Summit County Regional Pavement Marking Program (the
18 "Program") was submitted to this Council as part of the Capital Improvements Program for
19 2026-2031 pursuant to Resolution No. 2026-009; and

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21 WHEREAS, the work to be performed for the Program will be applying pavement
22 marking paint including center lines, edge lines, and lane lines to various County, city, village,
23 township, and Metro Park roads as listed below; and

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25 WHEREAS, the Engineer sent out eight bid packages and following the receipt and
26 review of three bids, the Executive proposes entering into a construction contract with American
27 Roadway Logistics, Inc., as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, for the 2026 Summit
28 County Regional Pavement Marking Program, in an amount not to exceed \$416,704.70; and

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30 WHEREAS, the contract total will be broken down by political subdivision as follows
31 with each subdivision responsible for directly paying the contractor:

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- 33 County share: \$301,456.60
- 34 City of Fairlawn: \$14,247.85
- 35 Village of Lakemore: \$9,699.30
- 36 Copley Township: \$10,087.00
- 37 New Franklin Township: \$24,049.75
- 38 Sagamore Hills Township: \$7,608.65
- 39 Springfield Township: \$894.00
- 40 Twinsburg Township: \$13,591.00
- 41 Metro Park: \$35,070.55

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45 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held on April 29, 2026, awarded a
46 construction contract with American Roadway Logistics, Inc., as the lowest responsive and
47 responsible bidder, for the 2026 Summit County Regional Pavement Marking Program, in an
48 amount not to exceed \$416,704.70, subject to confirmation by this Council; and

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50 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
51 that the aforementioned construction contract with American Roadway Logistics, Inc. for the
52 2026 Summit County Regional Pavement Marking Program is necessary and in the best interest
53 of the County of Summit;

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4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
5 of Ohio, that;

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7 SECTION 1

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9 The award by the Board of Control of a construction contract with American Roadway
10 Logistics, Inc. for the 2026 Summit County Regional Pavement Marking Program, in an amount
11 not to exceed \$416,704.70 is hereby confirmed and the Executive is hereby authorized to execute
12 said construction contract and any other necessary related documents.

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14 SECTION 2

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16 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
17 welfare of the residents of the County of Summit, and for the further purpose to immediately
18 provide necessary pavement marking to various County, city, village, township, and Metro Park
19 roads in 2026.

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21 SECTION 3

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23 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
24 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
25 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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27 SECTION 4

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29 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
30 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
31 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
32 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
33 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
