MEMBER JERRY FEEMAN**

With great sadness, Summit County Council President Elizabeth Walters announces the passing of District 6 Summit County Council Representative Jerry Feeman, 66, after a long illness. “Jerry was a dedicated public servant and a cherished member of Council. He will be greatly missed. Our thoughts are with his family and friends during this difficult time,” said Walters.

Councilman Feeman joined County Council after being elected in 2008, representing District 6 and dutifully serving the constituents of Tallmadge and neighborhoods in southeast Akron. He served as Council President for three consecutive years and most recently chaired the Public Works Committee. Mr. Feeman will be remembered for his collegiality and his many contributions to Summit County government, including his time spent as Council President and his part in the development of the Engineer’s paving program.

Prior to joining County Council, Jerry served Tallmadge as an at-large City Councilmember and served as the council’s president and vice president. He was a long-time realtor and served as a member of the Akron Area Board of Realtors, a member of Ohio Association of Realtors and a member of National Association of Realtors.
