**A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept an award of grant 2008-JG-A01-6401 from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services (OCJS), through the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for a county-wide Drug Unit task force, for the period 1/1/09 to 12/31/09, in the amount of \$80,400.00, with a 25% local cash match requirement of \$26,800.00, for a total project amount of \$107,200.00, and appropriating grant funds for 2009, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

WHEREAS, the County of Summit meets the Ohio Department of Public Safety, OCJS, and the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, funding requirements for a county-wide Drug Unit task force; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has been awarded Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) funds of \$80,400.00 with a 25% cash match requirement of \$26,800.00, which will be paid by Summit County Drug Unit Project Income checking account, for a project total of \$107,200.00, to fund a county-wide Drug Unit task force which will specifically target the manufacture, distribution and acquisition of illegal drugs in the County of Summit; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the aforementioned grant, and the appropriations of the aforementioned grant funds is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

#### SECTION 1

The Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept a county-wide Drug Unit task force grant award from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, OCJS, for the period 1/1/09 to 12/31/09, in the amount of \$80,400.00, with a local cash match requirement of \$26,800.00, for a total project amount of \$107,200.00.

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SECTION 2

The Funds are hereby appropriated for 2009 as follows:

SECTION 4

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to provide for the necessary authorization for the immediate acceptance and appropriation of the 2009 Summit County Drug Unit grant initiative.

SECTION 5

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 6

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
