WHEREAS, cash balances in the amount of \$203,950.48 remain available from prior years in the Emergency Management Program fund and the Hazardous Materials funds; and

WHEREAS, these available balances are required for current year activities; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the appropriation of the aforementioned funds are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

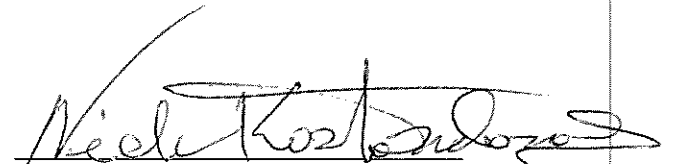
SECTION 5
