A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of various professional service contracts, a list of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten, to provide Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") employment related services for the period 7/1/09 through 6/30/10, for a total amount not to exceed \$323,300.00, with two options to renew for an additional one year period, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held May 27, 2008, awarded various professional service contracts, a list of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten, to provide Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") employment related services for the period 7/1/09 through 6/30/10, for a total amount not to exceed \$323,300.00, with two options to renew for an additional one year period, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

WHEREAS, County Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the aforementioned contracts are necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The award by the Board of Control of various professional service contracts, a list of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten, to provide Temporary Assistance to Needy Families ("TANF") employment related services, for the period 7/1/09 through 6/30/10, for a total amount not to exceed \$323,300.00, with two options to renew for an additional one year period, is hereby confirmed, and the County Executive is authorized to execute such contract.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately provide TANF employment related services.

SECTION 3

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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SECTION 4

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
