**A Resolution appropriating \$5,833.00 in federal funds, from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services for the Workforce Investment Act ("WIA") Disability Program Navigator ("DPN") Initiative Allocation, for the period 7/1/09 through 7/31/09, for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services ("ODJFS") has awarded State Fiscal Year 2010 WIA DPN funds in the amount of \$5,833.00 for the first month of the program year; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated by ODJFS that a second allocation will be distributed for the balance of the period 8/1/09 through 6/30/10 upon receipt of the federal award; and

WHEREAS, the award helps to fund a program which supports persons with disabilities in seeking employment; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the adjustment of the appropriation of the aforementioned grant funds is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

Appropriations are hereby appropriated as follows:

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason that the appropriation is needed for the Disability Navigator Program Services.

SECTION 4

Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

SECTION 5

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
