**A Resolution adjusting existing appropriations by \$667.00 within the Victims of Crime Act ("VOCA") Grant Program for the period 1/01/09 through 9/30/09, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2008-418 accepted and appropriated a 2009 VOCA grant award of \$65,577.00 for the Prosecutor's Office to fund victim advocates; and

WHEREAS, \$667.00 in original appropriations require an adjustment in order to provide services; and

WHEREAS, the grantor, being the Ohio Attorney Generals Office, has approved the adjustment; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the adjustment of the appropriation of the aforementioned grant funds is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 4




