8 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive, on behalf of the Sheriff's Office, to pay \$15,000.00**
9 **to Douglas Brown for the execution of a Release in order to resolve any and all claims, and**
10 **authorizing the Executive to execute the Release, for the Sheriff and the Executive, and**
11 **declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, on approximately February 21, 2010, while on the premises of the Sheriff's
14 Office, Douglas Brown was involved in an incident and claims certain injuries; and

15
16 WHEREAS, personnel of the Sheriff's Office conducted a review and investigation into
17 the matter; and

18
19 WHEREAS, based upon said review and investigation, the parties agree to resolve any
20 and all claims for the amount of \$15,000.00; and

22 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information
23 that authorizing the Executive to pay the sum of \$15,000.00 to resolve any and all claims is
24 necessary and in the best interest of the County;

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
27 of Ohio, that:

29 SECTION 1

31 The County Executive is hereby authorized to pay to Douglas Brown the sum of
32 \$15,000.00, for the execution by Douglas Brown of a full release of any and all claims against
33 the Sheriff's Office and the County of Summit. The Executive is further authorized to execute
34 the release and other documents necessary to protect the interests of the County.

36 SECTION 2

38 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
39 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will
40 immediately allow said payment.

42 SECTION 3

44 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
46 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
