7 **A Resolution appropriating \$1,547.31 in federal and state grant funds received from Ohio**  
8 **Attorney General Victims of Crime Act (“VOCA”) and State Victims Assistance Act**  
9 **(“SVAA”) grants, for the fiscal year ending 9/30/10, for the Prosecutor and declaring an**  
10 **emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, the County of Summit Prosecutor’ Office has been an ongoing recipient of  
13 VOCA and SVAA grants which help to support two full-time victim advocates; and

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15 WHEREAS, the required VOCA 25% local cash match requirement has been budgeted in  
16 the Prosecutor’s General Fund; and

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18 WHEREAS, the amount of \$1,547.31 of grant funding requires appropriation changes in  
19 order to meet the needs of the program; and

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21 WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has approved appropriation changes to the existing grant;  
22 and

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24 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is  
25 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the aforementioned  
26 funds in the amount of \$1,547.31;
