7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to**  
8 **accept the award of a Justice Assistance Grant (“JAG”) Victim Advocacy Grant from the**  
9 **Ohio Office of Public Safety, Office of Criminal Justice Services, in the amount of**  
10 **\$29,727.21, with a 25% local cash match requirement in the amount of \$9,909.07, and a**  
11 **supplemental cash match amount of \$624.00, required for certain employment**  
12 **expenditures not covered by the grant, for the period 1/1/11 through 12/31/11, and**  
13 **appropriating the amount of \$40,260.28, which includes the total local cash match**  
14 **requirement, for the Prosecutor, and declaring an emergency.**

16 WHEREAS, the Ohio Office of Public Safety/Office of Criminal Justice Services has  
17 awarded a JAG Victim Advocacy Grant in the amount of \$29,727.21, with a 25% local cash  
18 match requirement, in the amount of \$9,909.07, for the period 1/1/11 through 12/31/11; and

20 WHEREAS, an additional local cash match of \$624.00 is needed to cover the County’s  
21 costs of the employee’s hospital waiver and life insurance as these items are not covered under  
22 the grant guidelines; and

24 WHEREAS, the total local match of \$10,533.07 has been appropriated in the  
25 Prosecutor’s 2011 operating budget, appropriated in Resolution No. 2010-497; and

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27 WHEREAS, this annual funding supports a victim advocate position in order to provide  
28 the mandated services to victims of crime; and

30 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is  
31 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to execute  
32 any documents necessary to accept the award of the aforementioned grant from the Ohio Office  
33 of Public Safety/Office of Criminal Justice Services, and to appropriate said grant funds;

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35 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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40 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept  
41 the Justice Assistance Grant award from the Ohio Office of Public Safety/Office of Criminal  
42 Justice Services, in the amount of \$29,727.21, with a 25% local cash match requirement in the  
43 amount of \$9,909.07, and a supplemental cash match amount of \$624.00, required for certain  
44 employment expenditures not covered by the grant, for the period 1/1/11 through 12/31/11, for a  
45 total amount of \$40,260.28.
