7 **A Resolution appropriating carryover Chrysler Rapid Response stimulus funds from the**  
8 **American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (“ARRA”), in the amount of \$73,366.84,**  
9 **for the period 1/1/11 through 6/30/11, for the Executive’s Department of Job and Family**  
10 **Services, and declaring an emergency.**

11 WHEREAS, federal funds in the amount of \$249,181.76 from the ARRA were made  
12 available and appropriated in Resolution No. 2010-224 in May 2010 through the State of Ohio’s  
13 Workforce Investment Act (“WIA”) Rapid Response Grant and the National Emergency Grant  
14 (“NEG”) for the purpose of providing employment and skills counseling to displaced workers  
15 affected by layoffs at the Chrysler’s Twinsburg Stamping Plant and the plant’s eventual closure  
16 and assist such workers in locating and securing new employment and/or training opportunities;  
17 and

19 WHEREAS, the County of Summit, the County’s Department of Job and Family Services  
20 (“SCDJFS”) and the County’s Department of Community and Economic Development  
21 (“SCDCED”) entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) for providing the grant’s  
22 objectives with a term of 5/1/10 through 6/30/11; and

23  
24 WHEREAS, carryover appropriations are required to provide for the operating costs  
25 associated with the project for the balance of the grant term, including employee wages, benefits  
26 and additional expenses as set forth in Schedule B to the MOU, and Resolution No. 2010-189  
27 amends the Report on Staffing to allow for the temporary positions until 6/30/11; and,

29 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate these carryover funds from 2010 for 2011  
30 operations; and

32 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that the  
33 aforementioned appropriations, in the amount of \$73,366.04, are necessary and in the best  
34 interest of the County of Summit;

36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
37 of Ohio, that:

15 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately  
16 provide for the necessary appropriations for the Chrysler Rapid Response carryover grant funds.

20 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
21 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
22 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

27 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
