7 **A Resolution appropriating additional federal funds received from the Ohio Department of**  
8 **Public Safety for the High Visibility Enforcement Overtime (“HVEO”) 2011 grant, in the**  
9 **amount of \$8,382.40, through 9/30/11, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, County of Summit Sheriff’s Office has received a grant revision for an  
12 additional award of \$8,382.40 from the Ohio Department of Public Safety for the Fiscal Year  
13 2011 HVEO program; and

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15 WHEREAS, the original Fiscal Year 2011 award of \$66,665.73 for the HVEO program  
16 was appropriated in Resolution No. 2011-026 to support the efforts to increase community  
17 highway safety; and

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19 WHEREAS, the additional funds will provide for the purchase of two in-car video  
20 cameras for the Sheriff’s patrol vehicles; and

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22 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that it is  
23 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to appropriate the aforementioned  
24 funds in the amount of \$8,382.40;

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SECTION 4




