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6 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids to provide for all**
7 **materials needed for the construction of a salt dome at the County of Summit Engineer's**
8 **Office, 538 East South Street, Akron, Ohio 44311, in Council District 4, at an estimated**
9 **total cost not to exceed \$75,000.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, a salt dome is proposed for necessary additional salt storage at the Summit
12 County Engineer's South Street Station, 538 East South Street, Akron, Ohio 44311, in Council
13 District 4; and

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15 WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of the material is \$75,000.00, with designated
16 building funds coming from the sale of the Copley Station; and

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18 WHEREAS, the Council of Summit passed Resolution No. 2011-129 appropriating funds
19 received from the sale of the Copley Station property to be used for building improvements as
20 defined and approved by the Capital Improvements Program for 2011-2016; and

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22 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
23 requires this Council's approval for the County Executive to advertise for bids for projects that
24 are included in the Engineer's 2011 Capital Improvement Program; and

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26 WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that is
27 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit that the County Executive be
28 authorized to advertise for bids for the materials needed for a salt dome at the County of Summit
29 Engineer's Office, 538 East South Street, Akron, Ohio 44311, in Council District 4;

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31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
32 of Ohio, that;

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36 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for the materials needed for a
37 salt dome at the County of Summit Engineer's Office, 538 East South Street, Akron, Ohio
38 44311, in Council District 4, at an estimated total cost not to exceed \$75,000.00.

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42 This Resolution is declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and welfare
43 of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it will immediately
44 increase roadway safety by enabling the County Engineer's Office to have appropriate amounts
45 of salt storage for snow events.
