Mentoring	Catholic Charities/ Community Services	Primary focus is on younger, lower risk adjudicated offender. Each youth will spend three hours per week with a mentor for up to a three month period. Mentor, juvenile and parent will monitor progress.	\$ 25,000.00
Alternative School	The YMCA of Akron, Ohio, Inc.	Provides an alternative to traditional educational setting for students considered at risk for dropping out after completing court ordered probation through the implementation of GED and vocational programming.	\$ 80,000.00
Electronic Monitoring	Oriana House	Assist in supervising youth that require additional measures to remain in their homes, off the streets and out of Detention.	\$ 100,000.00
Day Treatment	Akron UMADAOP	Girls resolution program that seeks to educate girls ages 12 to 17 on the destructive behaviors that lead them to making poor decisions. Program focuses on behavioral changes and provides information on impulse control, relationships, assertiveness and conflict resolution.	\$ 80,000.00
Day Treatment	East Akron Community House	Program deals with decision making skills, anger management, values, conflict resolution, peer mediation as well as planning for future.	\$ 275,000.00
