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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to enter into agreements for the acquisition**
8 **of a drainage easement for the replacement of a crossover culvert, located in Sagamore**
9 **Hills Township, Council District 1, in an amount not to exceed \$300.00, for the Engineer,**
10 **and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, a right-of-way ("ROW") is needed for the replacement of a crossover
13 culvert located on Boyden Road in Sagamore Hills Township ("Project"); and

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15 WHEREAS, a ROW acquisition is considered a local cost which must be borne in whole
16 by the local public agency performing a project, and

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18 WHEREAS, the acquisition of the subject easements will promote proceeding with the
19 Project to bid; and

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21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
22 that the acceptance and approval of the aforementioned drainage easement acquisitions are
23 necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
26 of Ohio, that;

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28 SECTION 1

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30 In return for certain drainage easements ("DE-2") needed for the replacement of an
31 existing 24" CMP culvert with a new 24" culvert, the County Executive is hereby authorized to
32 execute agreements of purchase for said easements, under which the owners of said easements
33 will be paid amounts not to exceed \$300.00, said owner and their respective payment (the
34 negotiated value of their drainage easements) being as follows:

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41 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
42 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it immediately
43 promotes a county highway improvement project.

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47 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
48 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
49 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
