7 A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to
8 accept an award from the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Corrections of additional
9 Community Corrections Act grant funds in the amount of \$7,000.00, with no local cash
10 match requirement, and appropriating the total of \$7,000.00 for the state program year
11 ending 6/30/13, for the Executive's Department of Law, Insurance and Risk Management -
12 Division of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.

14 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Corrections ("ODRC") awarded
15 \$7,000.00 in additional funding for Community Corrections Act Adult Probation salaries, for the
16 state program year ending 6/30/13 ("SFY13"); and

18 WHEREAS, ODRC previously renewed an award to Summit County of a 407 program
19 grant for SFY13 in the amount of \$1,239,107.00 to support alternative community correction
20 programs for felony offenders in order to divert individuals from incarceration through programs
21 managed by Oriana House, Inc., and the County of Summit Probation Department; and

23 WHEREAS, this additional ODRC award is to support salaries for program quality
24 assurance testing; and

26 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
27 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
28 execute any documents necessary to immediately accept the award of the aforementioned grant
29 from ODRC, and to appropriate these grant funds;

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
32 of Ohio, that:

36 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary to accept
37 the award of additional funding for the Community Corrections Act program from the Ohio
38 Department of Rehabilitation and Corrections ("ODRC"), for the state program year ending
39 6/30/13, in the amount of \$7,000.00, with no local cash match requirement.
