7 **A Resolution determining to proceed with the submission to the electors of the County of**
8 **Summit the question of the renewal of an existing 2.95 mills tax levy for the purpose of**
9 **mental health and recovery programs for children, adults, and families for the County**
10 **service district, and for the acquisition, construction, renovation, financing, maintenance**
11 **and operation of the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health**
12 **Services Board facilities, for the Executive, and declaring an emergency.**

13
14 WHEREAS, on June 3, 2013, this Council adopted Resolution No. 2013-246 (the
15 "Resolution of Necessity") declaring the necessity of submitting to the voters of the County the
16 question of the renewal of a 2.95 mill tax levy in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the purpose
17 of mental health and recovery programs for children, adults, and families for the County service
18 district, and for the acquisition, construction, renovation, financing, maintenance and operation
19 of the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services ("ADM") Board
20 facilities; and

22 WHEREAS, the County Fiscal Officer has certified to this Council that the total current
23 tax valuation of the County is \$ 11,417,698,200. and that the 2.95 mills per each dollar of tax
24 valuation specified in the Resolution of Necessity will generate \$ 34,117,360 of revenue
25 per year in accordance with Section 5705.03(B) of the Ohio Revised Code, which certification is
26 attached hereto as Exhibit A (the "Fiscal Officer Certification"); and

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28 WHEREAS, this Council has received the report of the County of Summit Social
29 Services Advisory Board in accordance with the Resolution of Necessity approving the request
30 and proposal of the ADM Board for the approval of the aforesaid levy; and

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32 WHEREAS, this Council now determines to proceed with the submission of the question
33 of the renewal of the aforesaid levy to the voters of the County at the November 5, 2013 general
34 election;

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36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
37 State of Ohio, two-thirds of all the members elected thereto concurring, that:

39 SECTION 1

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41 The question of the renewal of an additional 2.95 mill tax levy for the purpose of mental
42 health and recovery services for children, adults, families and the elderly for the County service
43 district, and for the acquisition, construction, renovation, financing, maintenance and operation
44 of the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services ("ADM") Board
45 facilities, for a period of six (6) years, beginning with the 2014 tax list and duplicate, the
46 proceeds of which levy first would be distributed in calendar year 2015, shall be submitted under
47 provisions of Sections 5705.221 and 5705.25 of the Revised Code to the electors of the County
48 of Summit at the general election to be held therein on November 5, 2013, as authorized by law.
49 The election shall be held at the regular places of voting in the County as established by the

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6 Summit County Board of Elections, or otherwise, within the time provided by law and shall be
7 conducted, canvassed and certified in the manner provided by law.

25 A renewal of a tax for the benefit of County of Summit Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental
26 Health Services (ADM) Board for the purpose of mental health and recovery programs for
27 children, adults, and families for the County service district, and for the acquisition, construction,
28 renovation, financing, maintenance and operation of the County of Summit Alcohol, Drug
29 Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADM) Board facilities at a rate not exceeding 2.95 mills
30 for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 29.5 cents for each one hundred dollars of
31 valuation, for six (6) years.

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38 SECTION 3

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41 The Clerk of Council is authorized and directed to certify to the Board of Elections of
42 Summit County no later than August 7, 2013: (i) a copy of the Resolution of Necessity referred
43 to in the preambles hereto; (ii) the Fiscal Officer Certification; and (iii) a copy of this Resolution.
44 This Council requests that the Summit County Board of Elections give notice of the election and
45 prepare the necessary ballots and supplies for the election in accordance with law.

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47 SECTION 4

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49 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
50 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to timely certify to the
51 Summit County Board of Elections this ballot issue.

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4 SECTION 5

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6 Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
7 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
8 effect and be force at the earliest time provided by law.

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10 SECTION 6

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12 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
13 the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
14 deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
15 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
16 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
