7 **A Resolution, pursuant to Section 177.19 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of**  
8 **Summit, authorizing the disposal of 93 surplus firearms by the Sheriff through trade-in, in**  
9 **the amount of \$22,750.00 against the purchase of new supplies from Vance's Law**  
10 **Enforcement, for the Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

11  
12 WHEREAS, the County Sheriff is in the possession of 93 surplus firearms that are no  
13 longer needed for use by the Sheriff's office; and

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15 WHEREAS, the County Sheriff and County Executive have determined that disposal of  
16 said surplus firearms is necessary, and have received an offer from Vance's Law Enforcement to  
17 trade-in said firearms for the amount of \$22,750.00 against the purchase of new supplies; and

19 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 177.19 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of  
20 Summit, personal property cumulatively exceeding \$15,000.00 may be sold without a public  
21 auction or sealed bids if this Council finds good cause as to why a public auction or sealed bid is  
22 not warranted; and

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24 WHEREAS, this Council hereby finds that good cause exists not to sell said surplus  
25 firearms at a public auction or sealed bid and to instead deal directly with a dealer serving the  
26 law enforcement community; and

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28 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
29 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the disposal of said surplus  
30 firearms by the Sheriff through trade-in in the amount of \$22,750.00 against the purchase of new  
31 supplies from Vance's Law Enforcement;

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33 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
34 of Ohio, that:

36 SECTION 1

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38 This Council hereby authorizes, pursuant to Section 177.19 of the Codified Ordinances of  
39 the County of Summit, the disposal of 93 surplus firearms by the Sheriff through trade-in in the  
40 amount of \$22,750.00 against the purchase of new supplies from Vance's Law Enforcement. An  
41 itemization of the surplus firearms authorized to be disposed of above is attached hereto as  
42 Exhibit A.

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46 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
47 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason of immediately  
48 disposing of said surplus firearms and proceeding with purchasing of new supplies.

8 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.  
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
10 SECTION 4
