7 **A Resolution adjusting existing appropriations by \$14,000.00 within the Drug Law**  
8 **Enforcement Grant fund for Fiscal Year 2014, ending 12/31/14, for the Sheriff, and**  
9 **declaring an emergency.**

11 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2014-180, which authorized  
12 the County Executive to execute any documents necessary to accept the award by the Ohio  
13 Department of Public Safety's Office of Criminal Justice Services of a Drug Law Enforcement  
14 grant, in the amount of \$250,000.00, with a 25% local cash match requirement of \$83,333.33, for  
15 a total grant of \$333,333.33 with funding available through Fiscal Year 2014, ending 12/31/14;

18 WHEREAS, \$14,000.00 in current remaining funds were appropriated by Resolution No.  
19 2014-180 and require an adjustment in order to best meet the needs of the Sheriff's Office; and

21 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
22 that the adjustment of existing appropriations by \$14,000.00 within the Drug Law Enforcement  
23 fund for Fiscal Year 2014, ending 12/31/14, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of  
24 Summit;

16 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


