7 **A Resolution amending Resolution No. 2014-278 to authorize the County Executive,**
8 **through the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, to increase the transfer**
9 **amount in Title XX/TANF funds to Summit County Children Services from an amount not**
10 **to exceed \$350,000.00 to an amount not to exceed \$700,000.00 to be used for Non-Allocated**
11 **Children Services costs, and to execute any documents necessary to effectuate said transfer,**
12 **for the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the County Executive's Department of Job and Family Services ("DJFS") is
15 the recipient of certain Title XX/TANF funds, which it receives as part of its annual allocation;
16 and

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18 WHEREAS, on September 17, 2013, DJFS received an allocation notice from the State,
19 whereby the State set forth the Title XX/TANF allocations for DJFS for the period 10/1/13
20 through 9/30/14; and

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22 WHEREAS, the September 17, 2013 allocation notice indicates that DJFS has been
23 allocated Title XX/TANF funds in the amount of \$2,802,362.00 for the period 10/1/13 through
24 9/30/14; and

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26 WHEREAS, DJFS and Summit County Children Services ("SCCS") intend to enter into
27 an intergovernmental agreement, memorandum of understanding, or such similar document, in
28 order for SCCS to provide protective services for children and emancipating out of foster care
29 services; and

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31 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2014-278 originally authorized the County Executive,
32 through the Executive's Department of Job and Family Services, to transfer an amount not to
33 exceed \$350,000.00 in Title XX/TANF funds to SCCS; and

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35 WHEREAS, in exchange for providing such services, DJFS will transfer an amount not
36 to exceed \$700,000.00 of Title XX/TANF funds to SCCS to be used for Non-Allocated
37 Children's costs; and

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39 WHEREAS, upon review of the current balance of certain Title XX/TANF annual
40 allocations, DJFS desires to reallocate increased funding to SCCS; and

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42 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
43 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to amend Resolution No.
44 2014-278 to authorize the Executive to transfer of an amount not to exceed \$700,000.00 of Title
45 XX/TANF funds to SCCS, and to authorize the Executive to execute any documents necessary to
46 effectuate said transfer for the aforementioned reasons;

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48 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

SECTION 1

Resolution No. 2014-278 is hereby amended to authorize the County Executive, through the Department of Job and Family Services, to increase the transfer amount in Title XX/TANF funds to Summit County Children Services ("SCCS") to be used for Non-Allocated Children's Services costs from an amount not to exceed \$350,000.00 to an amount not to exceed \$700,000.00, and the County Executive is further authorized to execute any documents necessary to effectuate said transfer.

SECTION 2

This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason to immediately authorize the transfer of the increased amount in said Title XX/TANF funds to SCCS.

SECTION 3



SECTION 4




