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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with**
8 **Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc., for renewal of ArcGis software**
9 **maintenance, for the period 10/31/14 through 10/30/15, as Best Practical Source, approved**
10 **by the IT Board 10/21/14, in an amount not to exceed \$39,572.13, for the Executive's**
11 **Department of Community and Economic Development, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held October 22, 2014, awarded a
14 purchase order with Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc., for renewal of ArcGis
15 software maintenance, for the period 10/31/14 through 10/30/15, as Best Practical Source,
16 approved by the IT Board 10/21/14, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
19 that the purchase order is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
22 of Ohio, that:

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26 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase order with Environmental Systems
27 Research Institute, Inc., for renewal of ArcGis software maintenance, for the period 10/31/14
28 through 10/30/15, as Best Practical Source, approved by the IT Board 10/21/14, in an amount not
29 to exceed \$39,572.13, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to
30 execute such purchase order.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
36 provide ArcGis software maintenance renewal effective 10/31/14.

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40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

47 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
48 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
