7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a subgrant agreement with the**  
8 **Ohio Department of Job and Family Services and Ohio Department of Medicaid for grants**  
9 **received by Summit County Children Services, during State Fiscal Years 2016 and 2017,**  
10 **for the period 7/1/15 through 6/30/17, for the Executive’s Department of Job and Family**  
11 **Services, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, Section 5101.21 of the Ohio Revised Code states that, commencing 7/1/08,  
14 the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (“ODJFS”) may only make grants to counties  
15 through subgrant agreements as described in that Section; and

16  
17 WHEREAS, in conformance with Section 5101.21 of the Ohio Revised Code, ODJFS  
18 developed a standard subgrant agreement to be executed by the commissioners or the executive  
19 of each county prior to receiving Department of Job and family Services grant funds; and

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21 WHEREAS, effective with the term of the proposed subgrant agreement, the State has  
22 determined it necessary to add the Ohio Department of Medicaid (“ODM”) to the agreement due  
23 to the County’s receipt of funds from that agency; and

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25 WHEREAS, Summit County Children Services (“SCCS”) has received from ODJFS and  
26 ODM the standard subgrant agreement for State Fiscal Years (“SFY”) 2016 and 2017 that sets  
27 forth the rights and responsibilities of both ODJFS, ODM and SCCS in relation to any grant that  
28 is awarded for SFY 2016 and 2017; and

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30 WHEREAS, SCCS anticipates receiving grant funds from ODJFS for SFY 2016 and  
31 2017; and

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33 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
34 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to  
35 execute the aforementioned subgrant agreement for SFY 2016 and 2017;

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37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
38 of Ohio, that:

40 SECTION 1

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42 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a subgrant agreement with the  
43 Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (“ODJFS”) and the Ohio Department of Medicaid  
44 (“ODM”) for grants received by Summit County Children Services (“SCCS”) for State Fiscal  
45 Years (“SFY”) 2016 and 2017, for the period 7/1/15 through 6/30/17. A copy of said subgrant  
46 agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

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4 SECTION 2

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6 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and  
7 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further reason that it is necessary to  
8 immediately execute said subgrant agreement so that SCCS is eligible to be awarded grant funds  
9 from ODJFS and ODM for SFY 2016 and 2017.

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11 SECTION 3

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13 Provided this Resolution received the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
14 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
15 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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17 SECTION 4

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19 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
20 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
21 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
22 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
23 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


