7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute intergovernmental agreements**
8 **with Summit County municipalities for animal control services provided by the Division of**
9 **Animal Control, for five-year terms effective as of the date of the Executive's signature on**
10 **each agreement, for the Executive's Department of Administrative Services – Division of**
11 **Animal Control, and declaring an emergency.**

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13 WHEREAS, Summit County municipalities desire to engage the County to provide
14 certain services with regard to animal control and related matters within the municipality; and

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16 WHEREAS, the County is willing to provide said services through the County
17 Executive's Department of Administrative Services – Division of Animal Control; and

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19 WHEREAS; it is necessary for the County to enter into an intergovernmental agreement
20 with Summit County municipalities for said services;

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22 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
23 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to authorize the County Executive to
24 execute intergovernmental agreements with municipalities in Summit County for animal control
25 services performed by the Division of Animal Control, for five-year terms commencing upon the
26 Executive's signature;

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28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit,
29 State of Ohio, that:

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31 SECTION 1

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33 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute intergovernmental agreements
34 with Summit County municipalities for animal control services performed by the Division of
35 Animal Control, for five-year terms commencing upon the Executive's signature. The County
36 Executive is hereby authorized to execute said intergovernmental agreements in substantially the
37 form attached hereto as Exhibit A. The intergovernmental agreement is approved with changes
38 therein not inconsistent with this Resolution and not substantially adverse to the County which
39 shall be approved by the County Executive; provided that the approval of those changes by the
40 County Executive and the character of such changes as not being substantially adverse to the
41 County shall be evidenced conclusively by the execution of the intergovernmental agreement.

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43 SECTION 2

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46 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
47 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately
48 authorizing the Executive to execute necessary intergovernmental agreements for the County to
49 provide animal control services to Summit County municipalities given that the current
50 agreements have expired.

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6 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
7 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
8 effect and be in force at the earliest possible time provided by law.

13 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all
14 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,
