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15 WHEREAS, the Executive desires to grant a salary adjustment for classified non-
16 bargaining employee, Tenille Kaus; and

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18 WHEREAS, Section 169.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
19 requires County Council's approval for said salary adjustments; and

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21 WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Human Resources will review the
22 personnel action for the aforementioned salary adjustment as required by Section 169.07(b) of
23 the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit; and

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25 WHEREAS, the salary adjustment will be submitted to the Director of the Department of
26 Finance and Budget for the certification of availability of appropriated funds, as required by
27 Section 169.07(b) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit; and

30 the aforementioned salary adjustment is necessary and in the best interest of the County of
31 Summit;
