7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a super specific purchase**
8 **order for inmate boarding with other county and municipal jails and related medical**
9 **services, in an amount not to exceed \$280,000.00, for the Sheriff, and declaring an**
10 **emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, Section 341.12 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the sheriff of a county
13 where there is not adequate jailing capacity or staffing to convey inmates to a jail located in
14 another county; and

15
16 WHEREAS, after closing a wing of the Summit County Jail, the Sheriff has begun
17 sending inmates to jails in surrounding counties and municipalities, such as Stark County,
18 Geauga County, and the City of North Royalton; and

19
20 WHEREAS, Section 177.07(a)(2) of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
21 exempts from competitive bidding contracts with other governmental entities, including those
22 that would contract with the County to house inmates in their jails; and

24 WHEREAS, given the nature of the fluidity of inmate boarding needs and related medical
25 services, it is impossible to ascertain how much the County will ultimately spend with each
26 governmental entity or medical service provider, thereby necessitating a super specific purchase
27 order for these items with a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$280,000.00; and

29 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held June 1, 2016, awarded a super
30 specific purchase order for inmate boarding with other county and municipal jails and related
31 medical services, in an amount not to exceed \$280,000.00, subject to confirmation by County
32 Council;

34 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the County of Summit, State
35 of Ohio, that:

39 The award by the Board of Control of a super specific purchase order for inmate boarding
40 with other county and municipal jails and related medical expenses, in an amount not to exceed
41 \$280,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said
42 super specific purchase order.

46 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety, and
47 welfare of the County of Summit and for the further purpose of immediately allowing the Sheriff
48 to continue boarding inmates in other county and municipal jails.




