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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for the Juvenile Court**  
8 **Detention Lighting Upgrade Project, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$163,000.00,**  
9 **for the Executive's Department of Administrative Services- Physical Plants, and declaring**  
10 **an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit  
13 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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15 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for the Juvenile Court  
16 Detention Light Upgrade Project, in the City of Akron, in Council Districts 2, for an estimated  
17 total cost not to exceed \$163,000.00; and

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19 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications are attached as Exhibit A; and

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21 WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information  
22 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
23 advertise for bids for the aforementioned project;

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25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
26 of Ohio, that:

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28 SECTION 1

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30 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for the Juvenile Court Detention  
31 Lighting Upgrade Project, in the City of Akron, in Council District 2, for an estimated total cost  
32 not to exceed \$163,000.00.

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34 SECTION 2

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the  
38 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for the upgrade of lighting in the detention wing of  
39 the Juvenile Court facility.

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41 SECTION 3

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43 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
44 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
45 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.


