7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of an intergovernmental**
8 **agreement with the City of Akron to provide homeless prevention services through the**
9 **Home Again Homeless Crisis Response Program, for a one-year term, from 10/1/16**
10 **through 9/30/17, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00, for the Executive's Department of**
11 **Job and Family Services, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held August 3, 2016, awarded an
14 intergovernmental agreement with the City of Akron, for homeless prevention services through
15 the Home Again Homeless Crisis Response Program, for a one-year term, from 10/1/16 through
16 9/30/17, in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00, subject to confirmation by County Council;

19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information
20 that the aforementioned intergovernmental agreement with the City of Akron is necessary and in
21 the best interest of the County of Summit;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

28 The award by the Board of Control of an intergovernmental agreement with the City of
29 Akron to provide homeless prevention services through the Home Again Homeless Crisis
30 Response Program, for one-year term, from 10/1/16 through 9/30/17, in an amount not to exceed
31 \$200,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized such
32 intergovernmental agreement.

36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to provide for
38 homeless prevention services effective 10/1/16.

43 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
44 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
