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13 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held August 3, 2016, awarded a
14 professional service contract with Greenleaf Family Center to provide Barberton based
15 Supporting Partnerships to Assure Ready Kids services, for a one-year term, from 10/1/16
16 through 9/30/17, in an amount not to exceed \$55,000.00, subject to confirmation by County
17 Council; and

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19 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information
20 that the aforementioned professional service contract with Greenleaf Family Center is necessary
21 and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

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23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State

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28 The award by the Board of Control of a professional service contract with Greenleaf
29 Family Center to provide Barberton based Supporting Partnerships to Assure Ready Kids
30 services, for a one-year term, from 10/1/16 through 9/30/17, in an amount not to exceed
31 \$55,000.00, is hereby confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized such
32 professional service contract.

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36 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
37 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason provide Barberton
38 based Supporting Partnerships to Assure Ready Kids services effective 10/1/16.
