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7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a service/support agreement**
8 **with Smiths Detection, Inc., for technical monitoring equipment used by the Summit**
9 **County Special Operations Response Team, Hazardous Materials Branch, for the period**
10 **ending 3/31/2018, in an amount not to exceed \$63,790.00, for the Executive's Department of**
11 **Law, Insurance, and Risk Management- Division of Emergency Management- Division of**
12 **Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2016-199, which authorized
15 the County Executive to advertise for bids for a service/support agreement for Smith Detection
16 Equipment owned by the Summit County Special Operations team, for the period ending
17 3/31/2018, for an estimated total cost not to exceed \$90,959.60; and

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19 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held September 28, 2016, awarded a
20 service/support agreement with Smiths Detection, Inc., for technical monitoring equipment used
21 by the Summit County Special Operations Response Team, Hazardous Materials Branch, for the
22 period ending 3/31/2018, in an amount not to exceed \$63,790.00, subject to confirmation by
23 County Council; and

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25 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information,
26 that the aforementioned service/support agreement with Smith Detection, Inc. is necessary and in
27 the best interest of the County of Summit;

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34 The award by the Board of Control of a service/support agreement with Smiths
35 Detection, Inc., for technical monitoring equipment used by the Summit County Special
36 Operations Response Team, Hazardous Materials Branch, for the period ending 3/31/18, in an
37 amount not to exceed \$63,790.00 is hereby authorized and the County Executive is hereby
38 authorized to execute such service/support agreement.

44 provide for the necessary service/support for technical monitoring equipment used by the
