A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute a Local Public Agency agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation, for six traffic safety studies and one speed study, in Council Districts 1, 4, 5, and 8, for an estimated total cost of \$75,200.00, with a 10% local cash match requirement not to exceed \$7,520.00, for the Engineer, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, six traffic safety studies and one speed study have been approved for Federal Highway Administration funding, Project Identification ("PID") Number 106255 (the "Study") in Council Districts 1, 4, 5, and 8; and

WHEREAS, the Study's estimated total cost is \$75,200.00; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration monies have been awarded to the County Engineer's office for a grant, in the amount of \$67,680.00 to cover the 90% of the Study in the amount of \$67,680.00, with a 10% local match requirement not to exceed \$7,520.00, which will be paid from Motor Vehicle and Gas Tax funds; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") and the County Engineer desire to enter into a Local Public Agency ("LPA") agreement, to confirm the Study's Cost and to designate the County of Summit as the lead agency for administration of the Study; and

WHEREAS, Sections 5501.03 and 5543.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, and Article II, Section 2.03(5) of the County of Summit Charter, allow the execution of such agreements, subject to the approval of this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined by reviewing all pertinent information that authorizing the County Executive to enter into the aforementioned LPA agreement with ODOT is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1

The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into a Local Public Agency ("LPA") agreement with the State of Ohio, through the Department of Transportation ("ODOT"), for six traffic safety studies and one speed study, Project Identification ("PID") Number 106255, in Council Districts 1, 4, 5, and 8, for an total estimated cost of \$75,200.00, with 90% of the cost, in the amount of \$67,680.00, to be provided by ODOT, with 10% local cash match requirement not to exceed \$7,520.00. The Executive is hereby authorized to execute said LPA agreement in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A. Upon receipt of federal authorization from ODOT, the County may commence the administration of the Project, with any award related to the Project subject to applicable Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit, Ordinances, said Ordinances requiring authorization of any such awards by the Board of Control and/or County Council.
