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7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for a computer room**
8 **renovation project in the Children Services Administration Building, in Council District 4,**
9 **for an estimated cost not to exceed \$85,000.00, for the Executive's Department of**
10 **Administrative Services-Physical Plants Division, and declaring an emergency.**

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12 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit
13 requires this Council's authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

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15 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for a computer room
16 renovation project in the Children Services Administration Building, for an estimated cost not to
17 exceed \$85,000; and

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19 WHEREAS, a copy of the bid specifications is on file in the Clerk of Council's office;

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22 WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information
23 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to
24 advertise for bids for the computer room renovation project in the Children Services
25 Administration Building,;

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27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
28 of Ohio, that:

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30 SECTION 1

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32 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for bids for computer room renovation
33 project in the Children Services Administration Building, in Council District 4, for an estimated
34 cost not to exceed \$85,000.00.

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36 SECTION 2

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38 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and
39 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the
40 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for a necessary renovation of the computer room,
41 that will adequately size the room, upgrade the fire suppression system and HVAC system. The
42 renovation will also prolong the service life of the facility and provide a better environment for
43 the workers in the Children Services Building.

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45 SECTION 3

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47 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
48 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
49 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
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




