7 **A Resolution appropriating funds for the County Sheriff in the Drug Law Enforcement**  
8 **Grant in the amount of \$7,000.00 in carryover balance for calendar year 2018, for the**  
9 **Sheriff, and declaring an emergency.**

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11 WHEREAS, County Council previously adopted Resolution 2017-274, permitting the  
12 County Sheriff to execute any documents necessary to accept the award from the Ohio  
13 Department of Public Safety's Office of Criminal Justice Services, of a Drug Law Enforcement  
14 Fund grant, for the period 7/1/17 through 6/30/18, in the amount of \$249,999.88, with a 25%  
15 local cash match requirement of \$83,333.29, and appropriating funds in the amount of  
16 \$333,333.17; and

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18 WHEREAS, the County Sheriff has a Drug Law Enforcement Fund grant with a  
19 carryover balance of \$7,000.00, with an ending date of 6/30/18 from the Ohio Department of  
20 Public Safety's Office of Criminal Justice; and

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22 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate these carryover funds from 2017 for 2018  
23 operations; and

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25 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
26 that the aforementioned appropriations are necessary and in the best interest of the County of  
27 Summit;
