7 **A Resolution confirming an award by the Board of Control of a professional services**
8 **contract with THincIT for the purchase of the Forensic Advantage Medical Examiner**
9 **System, in an amount not to exceed \$131,860.00 for the System and one year of**
10 **maintenance, in an amount not to exceed \$54,560.00 for four additional years of**
11 **maintenance, for a total amount not to exceed \$186,420.00, for the Executive's Department**
12 **of the Medical Examiner, and declaring an emergency.**

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14 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its meeting held March 14, 2018, awarded a
15 professional services with THincIT for the purchase of the Forensic Advantage Medical
16 Examiner System, in an amount not to exceed \$131,860.00 for the System and one year of
17 maintenance, in an amount not to exceed \$54,560.00 for four additional years of maintenance,
18 for a total amount not to exceed \$186,420.00, subject to confirmation by County Council; and

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20 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,
21 that the aforementioned purchase contract with THincIT is necessary and in the best interest of
22 the County of Summit;

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24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State
25 of Ohio, that:

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27 SECTION 1

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29 The award by the Board of Control of a professional services contract with THincIT for
30 the purchase of the Forensic Advantage Medical Examiner System, in an amount not to exceed
31 \$131,860.00 for the System and one year of maintenance, in an amount not to exceed \$54,560.00
32 for four additional years of maintenance, for a total amount not to exceed \$186,420.00, is hereby
33 confirmed and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute such purchase contract.

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35 SECTION 2

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37 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of health, safety and
38 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately
39 provide the scalability and flexibility needed to support increasing case loads for the Medical
40 Examiner.

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44 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take
45 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take
46 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
