7 **A Resolution confirming the award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with**  
8 **Agilent Technologies, as a Best Practical Source, for the purchase of gas chromatography –**  
9 **mass spectrometry (“GCMS”) equipment, in an amount not to exceed \$73,742.90, for the**  
10 **Executive’s Department of the Medical Examiner, and declaring an emergency.**

11  
12 WHEREAS, the Board of Control, at its March 14, 2018 meeting, awarded a purchase  
13 contract with Agilent Technologies, as Best Practical Source, for the purchase of gas GCMS  
14 equipment, in a total amount not to exceed \$73,742.90; and

15  
16 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
17 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County to confirm the award of a purchase  
18 contract with Agilent Technologies, as Best Practical Source, for the purchase of GCMS  
19 equipment, in a total amount not to exceed \$73,742.90;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
22 of Ohio, that:

24 SECTION 1

26 The award by the Board of Control of a purchase contract with Agilent Technologies, as  
27 Best Practical Source, for the purchase of GCMS equipment, in a total amount not to exceed  
28 \$73,742.90, is hereby confirmed, and the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute said  
29 purchase contract and any necessary related documents.

31 SECTION 2

33 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
34 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
35 authorize necessary purchases for GCMS equipment because frequent breakdowns with the  
36 current equipment cause a delay in testing the issuance of results.

38 SECTION 3

40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

46 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
47 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
48 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
49 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
50 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
