7 **A Resolution authorizing the Executive to execute a collective bargaining agreement**  
8 **between the County of Summit, Summit County Engineer and Local 18, International**  
9 **Union of Operating Engineers, for the period 4/1/18 through 3/31/21, which authorizes a**  
10 **three percent increase in pay in each of the three years of the agreement, for the Executive**  
11 **and Engineer, and declaring an emergency.**

13 WHEREAS, a collective bargaining agreement has been reached between the County of  
14 Summit, the County Engineer, and Local 18, International Union of Operating Engineers, for the  
15 period 4/1/18 through 3/31/21, which authorizes a three percent increase in pay in each of the  
16 three years of the agreement; and

18 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information,  
19 that authorizing the Executive to execute a collective bargaining agreement with the Local 18,  
20 International Union of Operating Engineers, and the County Engineer, for the period 4/1/18  
21 through 3/31/21, is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
24 of Ohio, that:

26 SECTION 1

27  
28 The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute a collective bargaining agreement  
29 between the County of Summit, Summit County Engineer, and Local 18, International Union of  
30 Operating Engineers, for the period 4/1/18 through 3/31/21.

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32 SECTION 2

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34 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
35 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason to immediately  
36 provide a timely collective bargaining agreement between the parties.

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38 SECTION 3

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40 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
41 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
42 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

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44 SECTION 4

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46 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating  
47 to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all  
48 deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action,  
49 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section  
50 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


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
