7 **A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to advertise for bids for a parking lot**  
8 **improvement project at the Summit County Board of Elections, in Council District 4, for**  
9 **an estimated amount not to exceed \$175,000.00, for the Executive’s Department of**  
10 **Administrative Services-Physical Plants Division, and declaring an emergency.**

12 WHEREAS, Section 177.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the County of Summit  
13 requires this Council’s authorization for the County Executive to advertise for bids; and

14  
15 WHEREAS, the County Executive wishes to advertise for bids for a parking lot  
16 improvement project at the Summit County Board of Elections, in Council District 4, for an  
17 estimated cost not to exceed \$175,000.00; and

19 WHEREAS, copies of the project drawings and specifications are on file in the Clerk of  
20 Council’s office; and

22 WHEREAS this Council finds and determines, after reviewing all pertinent information  
23 that it is necessary and in the best interest of the County of Summit to authorize the Executive to  
24 advertise for bids for a parking lot improvement project at the Summit County Board of  
25 Elections;

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the County of Summit, State  
28 of Ohio, that:

30 SECTION 1

32 The County Executive is authorized to advertise for a parking lot improvement project at  
33 the Summit County Board of Elections, in Council District 4, for an estimated cost not to exceed  
34 \$175,000.00.

36 SECTION 2

38 This Resolution is hereby declared an emergency in the interest of the health, safety and  
39 welfare of the citizens of the County of Summit, and for the further reason that it authorizes the  
40 Executive to immediately advertise for bids for the aforementioned parking lot improvement  
41 project, in order to complete the previous renovation project, and improve the flow of traffic.

45 Provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of eight members, it shall take  
46 effect immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Executive; otherwise, it shall take  
47 effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.

10 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


